Customizing the LifeSize Video Center User Interface

With v1.1 and later, you can customize your LifeSize Video Center user interface to display your logo and favicon instead of the default LifeSize logo and favicon.

You can also add Javascript code to the **Page Footer** section of the user interface customization page to display your organization name in the web page title. Browsers display the web page title at the top of the browser window or tab. When a page is bookmarked, the bookmark is tagged using the the web page title.

Changing the Page Footer

- 1. Log in to LifeSize Video Center as an administrator.
- Navigate to Administer: System Settings: Appearance: Logos and messages: Configure: Page footer.
- 3. Enter the following script:

```
<script>
var page_title = $(document).attr("title").split("-");
var custom_site_title = "My Enterprise Name";
if (page_title.length > 1)
    page_title = custom_site_title + " - " + page_title[1];
else
    page_title = custom_site_title;
$(document).attr("title", page_title);
</script>
```

where My Enterprise Name is your organization's name.
